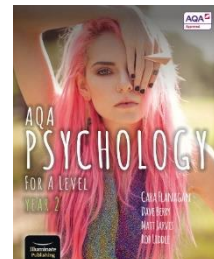
Three written papers each 2 hours long, each paper is worth 1/3 of the A Level qualification

- **7182/1 Paper 1:** Introductory topics in Psychology – this encompasses all of the AS topics and additional A2 knowledge.
- **7182/2 Paper 2:** Psychology in context – this encompasses the AS topics and additional A 2 knowledge.
- **7182/3 Paper 3:** Issues and options in Psychology – this paper is unique to the A Level course.
